Call to Order

Dr. Nash called the meeting to order at 12:40.

Public Comments

No public comments were made.

Approval of Previous Minutes

Jimmy Parker made a motion to approve the minutes as presented from the August 8, 2023 meeting. Joe Barkman seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Financial Updates (Teresa Giles, District Administrator)

The Revenue and Expense Summary Report was reviewed. The report covered July 1, 2023 through September 30, 2023.

- Being one-third of the way into the fiscal year, 24.97% of the budget has been expended.
- The following revisions were made to the budget since the last meeting:
 - 1) Adjustments were made to the cost of salaries and related fringe benefits.
 - 2) Increases were made to supplies, pharmaceuticals and utilities to meet FY24 projections.
 - 3) To offset those expenses, there was an increase from the inter-agency program by the amount of \$2789.00.
 - 4) The unassigned fund balance was increased by \$2794.00 to balance the budget.
- Berrien is currently in good financial shape.

Public Health Updates (Mark Eanes, MD, MBA, District Health Director)

- Dr. Kathleen Toomey, Public Health Commissioner, recently visited our District office. She was in Valdosta to attend a Boy Scout Association ceremony honoring Dr. William Grow with a Distinguished Citizen Award. Information was provided on a new program, "Healthy on Purpose". Healthy on Purpose is designed to help everyone make healthy choices and also used as an internal encourager in that everything we do has a purpose. Everything every employee does, with every interaction, has a purpose.
- Plans are being made to personalize the lobbies of our Health Departments. With permission, there will be large photos of patients who have given us permission to tell their stories. The pictures will have QR codes revealing their story either personally or in handwritten form. The purpose is to show services offered by our health departments.

- Updated information was provided on the adult RSV vaccine being recommended for people over age 60 with coexisting conditions. It has now been strongly suggested that it be recommended by the patient's primary care provider for those in this age group. A protocol is being developed to follow these recommendations. The vaccine will be offered to anyone over age 75 to help prevent hospitalizations in this group.
- Turner County Health Department has a kiosk for Covid and Influenza A and B testing. Berrien will also be getting a kiosk in the next few weeks. There should be a 6-to-30-hour response time for results which will be confirmed. If the turnaround time is accurate, then additional kiosks will be placed in the rural counties.
- There is a vacant board position. The position is for a Nurse or Consumer appointed by the City of Nashville.

Women's Health Updates (Missy Sims, RN, Women's Health Coordinator)

- Dr. Eanes introduced Missy Sims, RN with our Women's Health Program. Women's Health is the program highlighted at the meeting this month.
- Handouts were distributed and a brief overview was given about each of the various programs under Women's Health.
- October is Breast Cancer Awareness month. Women's Health staff will be in the various communities during the month handing out flyers about breast cancer and other Women's Health programs.
- A display was available showing the various birth control methods available thru the Family Planning Program.
- A success story was shared with the group about a 29-year-old Berrien patient diagnosed with cervical cancer who was seen in our Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP). She was put on Women's Health Medicaid and received cancer treatment. This is an example of these programs working to help people in the community.

Health Department Updates (Dawn Bowen, RN, County Nurse Manager)

- Flu clinics have been provided in all the schools vaccinating 141 teachers and students.
- Over 150 students were vaccinated during back-to-school events.
- Senior Citizens Center will receive flu vaccinations this week.
- Reminder letters have been sent to BCCP patients reminding them to call for their preventive appointments. Information and awareness activities are also being made available to the public.
- Covid home test kits are still provided to the community free of charge.
- Diabetes awareness will be promoted during the month of November.
- An open day clinic for free STD services will be held in December.

Environmental Health Updates (Lee Meeks, Environmental Health Specialist)

- The Environmental Health Activities Report and Food Service Inspections Report was reviewed from August 4 through October 22, 2023.
- There have been no issues with Food Service Facilities.
- There was discussion about Environmental Health issues and activities during Hurricane Idalia.

- Food service inspection fee billing for this fiscal year has been sent out and approximately 50% of the fees have been paid.

Adjournment

There being no further business, a motion was made by Jimmy Parker to adjourn at 1:20 PM. The motion was seconded by Deree Nix. All were in favor and the motion passed.
