Call to Order

Jason Shaw called the meeting to order at 12:13 PM.

Introductions

Introductions were made throughout the Board and Public Health staff.

Oath

Jennifer Durrance was sworn onto the Lanier County Board of Health.

Public Comments

There were no public comments.

Approval of Previous Minutes

Gene Culpepper motioned to approve the minutes from September 22, 2023. Jack Paulson second the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Financial Updates (Teresa Giles, District Administrator)

The Revenue & Expense Summary was presented and showed no changes since the previous meeting.

Public Health Updates (Mark J. Eanes, MD, MBA, District Health Director)

- Dr. Eanes highlighted the new "Healthy on Purpose" mission that is being launched in the ten-county district. He encouraged members to look at the new, redesigned, website.
- First Amendment Auditors have been showing up at several of the health departments throughout the district representing the Open Records Act. They are allowed to record videos and audios in the lobbies but are not allowed to film patients nor enter clinical areas. A written policy is being developed to address the Open Records Act.
- There has been a small uptick in Covid cases.

Children 1st Updates (Reomona Thomas, RN, Children 1st Coordinator)

Reomona presented an overview of the Children 1st program. This program is for children ages birth to 5 years who are at risk for poor growth and learning. They currently have three registered nurses and one developmental specialist on staff. Around 400 families are seen yearly in the program.

Health Department Updates (Lauren Lee, RN, County Nurse Manager)

- There have been 487 individuals served in the clinic since the September meeting.
- Participation with school-based flu has increased in the last two years, since Covid.
- Annual immunization audits have been completed for county school and childcare facilities, with everyone receiving a passing score.
- The health department participated in a community outreach at the local Fall Festival giving out more than 200 toothbrushes as prizes. Staff also participated in the elementary school's Fall Walk providing over 800 toothbrushes.

Environmental Health Updates (Lee Meeks, MPH, Environmental Health Specialist)

The Environmental Health activities report was presented for September to December 2023. Lanier now has 28 food service establishments. There are plans to visit restaurants more than the mandated twice a year. He wants owners/managers to know he is always available.

Announcements

- A proposal was sent prior to the meeting about amending the Bylaws to change the meeting dates. Jack Paulson motioned for the new Bylaws to be approved. Mayor Bill Darsey seconded the motion. All agreed and the motion passed.
- The next board meeting is scheduled for Friday February 23, 2024.

Adjournment

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 12:45 PM.
