Call to Order

Dr. Nash called the meeting to order at 12:40 PM.

Public Comments

There were no public comments.

Approval of Previous Minutes

Joe Barkman made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 13, 2024, meeting as presented. John Clayton seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Business- Financial Updates (Allie Pridgen)

Mrs. Pridgen, Director of Finance for South Health District, introduced Tiffany Cannon, Accounting Supervisor. Ms. Cannon will be filling in for Mrs. Pridgen at the August meeting.

- Mrs. Pridgen presented the Revenue and Expense Summary Report to the Board for July 1, 2023 – March 31, 2024. This report is different than past reports as it includes the Revised Budget and the Original Budget that was approved last year.
- The total budget has been increased by \$51,523.
- Intra Agency Transfer from Lowndes was increased by \$4952 to reflect a one-time \$1000 retention supplement that was given to all staff.
- Grant-In-Aid decreased by \$14,247 to reflect the actual funds that was received from the State in FY24.
- The Proposed Berrien County Health Department's FY25 Budget was presented with a total of \$670,652 with an increase of \$17,457.
- Prior year's fees have increased by \$29,406. Fees collected as of March 31st are reviewed and projections made as to what will be collected in April – June of this year to budget and spend next year.
- Under the Expenses section of the proposed FY25 Budget the only thing that changed is the 4% anticipated salary increase from the State.
- After review and discussion, a motion was made by Robin Marcrum to approve the proposed FY2025 Budget as presented. The motion was seconded by Samantha Warren. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Public Health Updates (Dr. Mark Eanes)

• Dr. Eanes introduced Karen Harrison as the new administrative assistant.

- South Health District held a Customer Service Training class along with our Employee Appreciation Day on April 29. The training included how to present ourselves professionally. The training is to improve our communication skills in how to better serve both internally and externally. Dr. Eanes congratulated Deborah Tomlinson on her 35 years of service.
- Dawn Bowen, CNM was a recipient to receive a scholarship for the Nurse Practitioners Program. She was one out of four that applied and was awarded.
- Pictures with QR codes have been placed in our lobby for patients in the community to scan with their phones. It will give patient encounter stories and highlight the services our health department provides.
- Dr. Eanes informed the board of the Bird Flu outbreak that is affecting the poultry industry. It is known to be transmitted through dairy cattle only, however there are no signs in beef cattle. It has been reportedly passed to only one human at this time in the form of conjunctivitis. No other human transmissions have been reported.
- Legislative updates were discussed today with Bill 293 being passed. AED, PREP for rape victims, DPH Clean-up Bill. The Telecommunications Bill submitted by Public Health did not pass. This Bill states that Board of Health meetings must be held in person.
- Dr. Eanes presented a Memorandum of Understanding to our Board Chairman for his signature stating we would share staff in other counties if needed while someone was out and will get paid by the county in which they are employed at.

Opioid Discussion (Ambreshia Allen)

Ms. Allen, Opioid Prevention Specialist with South Health District provided information. on Opioid Prevention and well as the use for Narcan.

- Ms. Allen provided a Factsheet for Berrien County's Overdose Surveillance and for opioids. Berrien County is one the top 5 counties with a high of overdose rate in this District.
- Ms. Allen informed the Board of a \$636 million-dollar Opioid Settlement Funding that will be distributed throughout the cities and counties in Georgia based on their population and size within a twelve-year time span. The District Opioid Prevention program will assist and provide training for members and their staff.

Health Department Updates (Dawn Bowen)

- Dawn Bowen, RN, County Nurse Manager, reviewed services provided by the Berrien County Health Department from January March 2024.
- We have 2 RNs that are trained to do Nexplanon insertions and training for Nexplanon removals. When their checkoffs are completed, patients will no longer have to wait for a District Nurse Practitioner to be present to receive these services.
- We are preparing for our back-to-school vaccinations and eye, ear, and dental screenings.
- Ms. Bowen attended the Georgia Public Health Convention recently. She stated she has noticed an increase in the need for more STD Prevention and HIV PREP services.

Environmental Health Update (Lee Meeks)

- The Environmental Health Activities Report for January 1, 2024 through March 31, 2024 and the Food Service Inspections Report were reviewed with the Board.
- All Food Service Fees for FY 24 have been collected.

- The Body Art Rule was discussed. The State passed legislation last year, which adopted a Statewide Body Art Rule which is now in effect.
- We are now asking each Board of Health to adopt as a local ordinance which can be enforced at a local level with the Magistrate Court instead of going before the Superior Court. We have one body art studio in Berrien County at the present time.
- After review and discussion, a motion was made by John Clayton to adopt the Body Art Rule. Joe Barkman seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

• There being no further business, a motion was made by Robin Marcrum to adjourn the meeting at 1:35PM. The motion was seconded by Samantha Warren. All were in favor and the motion passed.
