Introductions

Introductions were made throughout the Board and Public Health staff. Patricia Gordon was introduced as a new board member and sworn in by Karen Harrison.

Public Comments

There were no public comments.

Approval of Previous Minutes

Mayor Bill Darsey motioned to approve the minutes for February 23, 2024. Jennifer Durrance second the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Financial Updates -Allie Pridgen, (Director of Finance)

- The Revenue & Expense Summary for July 1,2023 – March 31, 2024, was presented to board members and reviewed.
- The new budget summary for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025, was presented to the board for approval.
 - Mayor Bill Darsey motioned to approve the FY25 budget. Jennifer Durrance second the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Public Health Updates- Mark J. Eanes, MD, MBA, (District Health Director)

- Dr. Eanes discussed with the board the Customer Service Employee Day that all ten counties within the district participated in. The hope is to promote great customer service for the South Health District.
- Dr. Eanes stated the Bird Flu was on the rise. It has been mainly found in our dairy cattle, through unpasteurized milk. There has been only one human known case, and it was in the form of conjunctivitis.
- Dr. Eanes reviewed several new bills that have been passed since the Georgia Legislature last met.

Adolescent Health & Youth Development- Percy Chastang, MPH

Mr. Chastang provided board members with a brief description of his program. He stated that he participates in several health fairs and youth programs that promote adolescent health and development.

Mr. Chastang added a new employee to his team which will allow more outreach for teens, not only in Lanier County, but also throughout the district.

Opioid Discussion- Ambreshia Allen, MPH

Ms. Allen gave a quick overview of the Opioid Prevention program. She provided board members with a flier about overdose surveillance and response planning for Lanier County.

Ms. Allen provided board members with her contact information and encouraged them to reach out if help was needed.

Election of New Board Secretary

Mayor Bill Darsey motioned for Patricia Gordon to become the new board secretary.

Jennifer Durrance second the motion. All were in favor and the position passed.

Health Department Updates- Lauren Lee, RN, (County Nurse Manager)

Ms. Lee reviewed the nurse managers report.

Ms. Lee stated with the help of school registrars, the health department has been able to get a jumpstart for 7th/11th graders in getting their updated vaccines.

Environmental Health Updates -Lee Meeks, MPH, (Environmental Health Specialist)

- The Environmental Health activities for January 1, 2024 – March 31, 2024, were presented to the board and reviewed. All fees for food establishments for fiscal year 2024 have been paid.
- The new statewide body art rule was reviewed by the board members.
 - Mayor Bill Darsy motioned to approve the new rule. Jennifer Durrance second the motion. All were in favor and the new body art rule was adopted.
