- Dr. Eanes updated the board regarding the Customer Service Survey. All health departments are participating. Results will be included in the meeting packets.
- Dr. Eanes stated there was a confirmed case of measles that had been identified in Atlanta. Dr. Eanes advocates for vaccinations as an essential strategy to prevent the transmission of disease.

Emergency Preparedness (Lauren Robinson, B.S.Ed., GA-ACEM, EMHP)

Lauren presented a comprehensive overview of the Emergency Preparedness Department, which operates across the 10-county district. The department works in close partnership with local agencies to ensure the development of plans for large-scale events and emergency weather shelters.

Health Department Updates (Lauren Lee, RN, County Nurse Manager)

- Lauren and her team have provided services to 240 clients in the most recent quarter, of which 13 are new clients.
- Lauren stated a school flu clinic has been scheduled for the first week of October.
- Lauren updated the board on the new health department. It is projected to be completed in October. The November meeting be held in the new facility.
