Call to Order

Jason Shaw called the meeting to order at 12:30pm.

Introduction

No new introductions were made.

Approval of Previous Minutes

Gene Culpepper motioned to approve the minutes from November 22, 2024. Alex Lee seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Financial Updates - Allie Pridgen, Director of Finance

- Allie gave an update on the Revenue and Expenses Report for July 1, 2024-December 31, 2024.

Public Health Updates - Mark J. Eanes, MD, MBA, District Health Director

- Dr. Eanes updated the board with the Quarterly Customer Feedback report for October- December 2024.
- Dr. Eanes stated RSV, Flu, and Covid have peaked.
- Dr. Eanes updated on Bird Flu.
- Dr. Eanes discussed with the board the Federal Funding Freeze.
- Dr. Eanes announced the state is reviewing adult vaccines and will be discontinuing the noncommunicable disease vaccines to cut down on costs during the freeze.
- Dr. Eanes stated that congenital syphilis is still on the rise in Georgia.
- Dr. Eanes stated all health departments will continue to educate clients on syphilis and getting tested, especially pregnant women.
- Dr. Eanes introduced the Drug Train Security Act, which will require that all medications are tracked and scanned as they are dispensed and received between clinics. This will begin in October 2025.
- Dr. Eanes announced that the PREP program is available in all county health departments.

- Dr. Eanes reminded the board that we must have an in-person BOH meeting, stating members that were out and chose to call in would not be able to vote and will not count towards the quorum.
- Dr. Eanes informed the board that GPHA was cancelled this year due to the federal freeze.
- Dr. Eanes updated on the District Office move to the Bank of America Building in Valdosta.

Human Resources- Chris Foreman

- Chris gave a broad overview of Human Resources within the South Health District.
- Chris stated that we have a new Workforce Development Coordinator.
- Chris informed the board that we are implementing new customer service plans with new hires and current staff members.

Oral Health - Cumi Fillion

Cumi presented the board with a detailed, visual presentation on the importance of oral health.

Health Department Updates- Lauren Lee, RN, County Nurse Manager

- Lauren reviewed the number of clients served at the Lanier County Health Department between October- December 2024.
- Lauren stated numbers are down due to Hurricane Helene and health department being closed.
- Lauren announced the ribbon cutting ceremony for the new Lanier County Health Department scheduled for March 21, 2025 from 12:00-2:00pm.

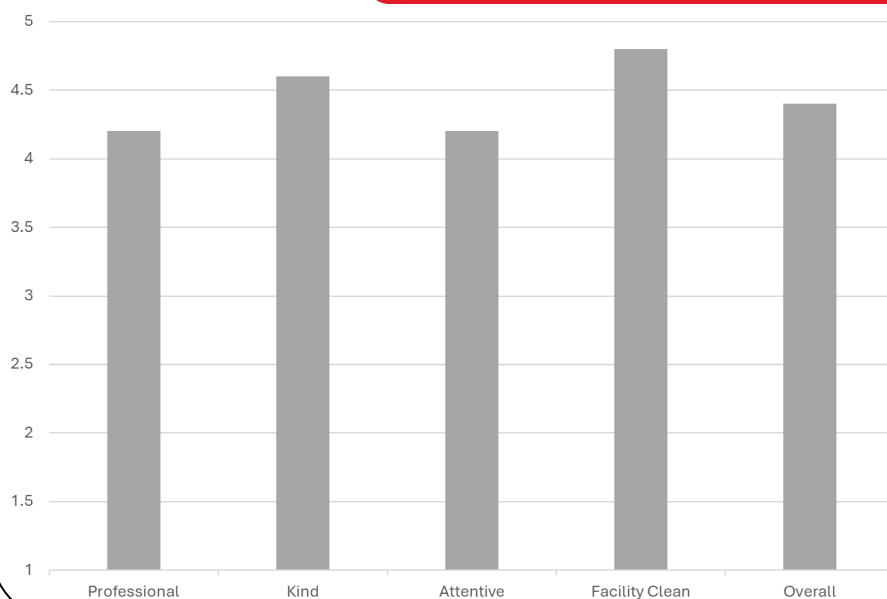
